# PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR OB-GYN SET

1. REFERENCES:

- a. NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2019-002 entitled, "Defining the Duty and Authority of the NAPOLCOM to Prescribe Minimum Standards for Uniforms, Arms, and Equipment to be Procured by the Philippine National Police" dated January 29, 2019;
- b. NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2015-019 entitled, "Prescribing the Guidelines to Determine Whether a Consumable or Expandable Item and/or Small Tangible Asset Intended to be Procured by the PNP Will Need a NAPOLCOM Approved Specifications as Generally Required for Purposes of Procurement" dated January 23, 2015;
- c. Minutes of the Uniform and Equipment Specifications Board Meeting conducted on October 3, 2023; and
- d. Memorandum from Director, Health Service with attached Health Service Table of Equipment and Allowances.

#### 2. RATIONALE:

This MC sets forth the technical specifications for OB-Gyn Set used by healthcare providers to safely perform all abdominal gynecologic cases.

#### 3. SITUATION:

The PNP Health Service is mandated to provide timely, comprehensive, and quality health services to PNP personnel, their dependents, and authorized civilians. At present, the PNP General Hospital (PNPGH) is the only PNP Level II hospital that caters to the hospitalization needs of PNP personnel and their dependents. Unfortunately, its capability is still limited, thus, its enhancement through procurement of medical equipment and supplies is needed.

The PNP intends to procure OB-Gyn Set for use of the PNPGH and Medical Plaza to help surgeons and other healthcare providers to safely perform all abdominal gynecologic cases. The gynecological surgical instrument set is needed in performing abdominal gynecologic procedures including but not limited to TAHBSO (Total

Abdominal Hysterectomy Bilateral Salphingo-Oophorectomy), pelvic laparotomy, myomectomy, ovarian surgeries, and fallopian tube/ectopic pregnancy surgeries.

Under NAPOLCOM No. 2015-019 dated July 14, 2014, it prescribes that the Commission does not need to set the technical specifications of consumables and/or expendable supplies, to which the components of OB-Gyn Set are included.

#### 4. PURPOSE:

To establish the technical specifications of OB-Gyn Set that will serve as reference in its procurement.

### 5. **DEFINITION OF TERMS:**

For the purpose of this MC, the following terms, words, and phrases shall mean or be understood, as follows:

- a. Abdominal Retractor <sup>1</sup> a surgical instrument used for retracting abdominal thick tissues and skin.
- b. Army Navy Retractor<sup>2</sup> a basic surgical instrument included in most minor and major surgical set used for shallow or superficial tissues.
- c. Allis³ a toothed surgical instrument, used to grasp firm tissues (such as fascia).
- d. Babcock<sup>2</sup> a jawed instrument with a smooth end, allowing for more delicate structures to be held in an atraumatic manner.
- e. Balfour Abdominal Retractor<sup>4</sup> a self-retaining retractor used during surgeries in which large abdominal incisions need to be held open to provide more visibility to the surgeon.
- f. Deaver Retractor<sup>2</sup> a surgical instrument used in a wide range of surgical procedures. It is a versatile instrument that is used to retract tissues and organs during surgery to improve visualization and facilitate access to the surgical site.
- g. Debakey Forceps³ non-toothed forceps used in a wide variety of procedures most importantly to grasp tissues without damaging them.
- h. Heaney Forceps<sup>2</sup> used to excise the uterus from its adnexal ligaments and tissues.



- Kelly Forceps<sup>5</sup> a clamp of larger size variation of hemostat with similar function for grasping larger tissues or vessels.
- j. Kidney Basin<sup>6</sup> a shallow basin with a kidney-shaped base and sloping walls. It serves many purposes that include collecting everything from tissue or objects extracted from the body during surgeries.
- k. Lahey Forceps<sup>2</sup> used to grasp and manipulate soft tissues and vessels, in order to pass suture threads around them and perform ligature.
- Malleable Ribbon Retractor<sup>2</sup> used to hold back tissues and organs during surgery. They are suitable for abdominal, cardiovascular, ophthalmic, and neurosurgical procedures.
- m. Mayo Scissors<sup>2</sup> a heavy scissors, with semi-blunt ends, often used to cut thick tissues or sutures, either straight or curved.
- n. Metzenbaum Scissors<sup>4</sup> a lighter scissors used for delicate tissue and for blunt dissection. It is also called "Metz" in practice.
- Mixter Forceps<sup>7</sup> comprised of fully curved delicate and serrated jaws that allow surgeons to get a hold of blood vessels that may be obstructed by tissue.
- p. Mosquito Forceps<sup>2</sup> a multi-purpose surgery instrument used to handle the blood vessels and prevent blood loss by controlling the bleeding during surgical procedures.
- q. Needle Holder² used for holding needles and comes in varying sizes and length depending on the needle and tissue in question.
- r. Ochsner Forceps<sup>8</sup> a hemostat that is helpful in clamping off blood vessels to avoid bleeding during procedures such as orthopedic surgery.
- s. Ovum Forceps<sup>9</sup> an angled, non-ratchet forceps that has straight jaws which end in oval tips with indentations to grip the soft tissue better.
- t. Pean Curved Forceps<sup>2</sup> a forceps with long serrated jaws primarily used as hemostatic agent to clamp bigger blood vessels.
- u. Richardson Retractor² a retractor that can be used during procedures to grasp soft tissues.

- v. Scalpel Handle<sup>10</sup> a small and extremely sharp instrument used to hold the scalpel blade for surgery, and anatomical dissection.
- w. Schnidtz<sup>1</sup> a hemostatic agent used to cease bleeding from blood vessels.
- x. Schroeder Vulsellum Forceps<sup>11</sup> an instrument that is suitable for gripping the uterus in gynecological procedures. It has a finger ring handle for convenient manipulation.
- y. Singley Tissue Forceps<sup>2</sup> a multipurpose surgical instrument commonly used for grasping delicate internal tissues. It is often used to grip intestines and other internal organs while minimizing inflicted damage.
- z. Specimen Collection Container2 proper container to preserve and protect the specimen.
- aa. Tenaculum<sup>2</sup> a surgical instrument, usually classified as a type of forceps. It consists of a slender sharp-pointed hook attached to a handle and is used mainly in surgery for seizing and holding parts, such as blood vessels.
- bb. Thumb Forceps<sup>4</sup> used for fine handling of tissue and traction during dissection.
- cc. Tissue Forceps used to hold soft tissues during multiple surgical procedures. It comes with teethed tips and a serrated surface.
- dd. Towel Clip<sup>2</sup> most commonly used to secure towels or drapes in place, however, can be used to grasp tissue if required.


